Hannah Bull, 35, and her husband Rob, 38, ditched their life, jobs and home in the UK, and decided to see the world. Along the way, they picked up odd jobs, such as tending to animals or looking after horses in Arizona. They also taught English to pupils at a kindergarten in Budapest and helped edit a book in Costa Rica.
- 2. Hannah and Rob, who initially planned to travel for just a few years, now expect to maintain their wanderlust lifestyle by becoming digital nomads. They have always had the travel bug. They first went on an extended holiday and spent two months on the beach in San Diego, California, Hannah claimed that trip cemented in their minds what they wanted to do for a long time: travelling. The pair began saving up money to pursue their dreams. However, they didn't actually quit their jobs and go abroad until 2022.
- 3. "The pandemic forced us to step back and gave us a change in our normal lives. It taught us that we never know what's around the corner and so we just went for it," Hannah said. At first, the Bulls travelled, surviving on their savings. Then, they expanded their travel timeline by picking up freelance work and other odd jobs. This allowed them to get first-hand experience with the community and live like a local, not a tourist.
- 4. "It can be daunting to be pushed out of where we feel safe and in control, especially when arriving to a new country, stranger's home or new workaway assignments. Yet, it is exciting at the same time because it's a new adventure that keeps adrenaline pumping. Our best advice: Take that leap of faith, even if against all reason! We left our home, jobs and family, but we have learnt if you open yourself up to opportunities, you'll be rewarded along the way," they said.
